Current Lane County high school juniors and seniors are invited to apply for a paid summer internship experience in the industry of their choice! Student applications will be reviewed, interviews will be scheduled with those who qualify, and then students will be matched with a local host company.

Industry hosts will identify 2-4 projects for the intern to work on during the experience. Students and industry will review the projects, identify learning objectives and key skills to build during the internship experience.
