**TO DO:**

- Make sure parents/guardians and students are registered in Home Access.** Please take this opportunity to make sure that we have the correct phone number, email, and mailing address on file for parents/guardians and emergency contacts. **If parents/guardians have more than one student and you would like them linked together into one account for Home Access, please contact the CMS office.**
- Read the 2021-2022 CMS Student Handbook** on the CMS website. Your student will also be given a paper copy of this on the first day of school. Please sign and return the enclosed form indicating that you read and understand the expectations of the handbook on the first day of school to your first period teacher.
- Chromebook Checkout. Parents/Guardians and students sign and return the enclosed "Student Agreement for an Electronic Communications System Account" form before they will be issued a Chromebook. Students will be issued Chromebooks by their Homeroom Teachers. Students wishing to take home their devices to work, may do so with this teacher as well.**
  - 6th grade students will check out their Chromebook on September 8<sup>th</sup> during their Orientation Day which is 8:20 AM-11:20 AM at CMS. Chromebooks will only go home with students when they are needed for work and will be checked out through the student's homeroom teacher.
  - 7th and 8th grade students will check out their Chromebook on September 9<sup>th</sup> (the first day of school). Chromebooks will only go home with students when they are needed for work and will be checked out through the student's homeroom teacher.
- School Supplies-** If you need help getting supplies at home please contact the Family Resource Center at [kdumas@creswell.k12.or.us](mailto:kdumas@creswell.k12.or.us). A list of school supplies was sent home earlier this month, and can also be found on our school website. Specific classes may also have additional supplies needed, so your teacher(s) will be reaching out if this is the case. Please note that many supplies will be given to students when they submit their student body fee.

- Parents/Guardians-** If your student receives special services, and you have questions, please contact your student's case manager via email or contact the main office.
- Parents/Guardians who enroll their student in the CMS Creswell Online Academy should attend the CMS COA Orientation on Zoom Wednesday, September 1, at 5:00 PM.**
- 6th grade students and their parents/guardians should attend the CMS 6th grade Information Night on Zoom Wednesday, September 1, at 6:00 PM.**
- 6th Grade Student Welcome Orientation (in-person)** will be held on September 8<sup>th</sup> from 8:20 to 11:20am. Transportation will be provided to those students who live in the bussing zone. Please contact Sarah Hanson at the Transportation Department (895-6009) to sign up for this service.
- Classes start for all grades on September 9<sup>th</sup> at 8:20am. Students should not be on campus before 8:00 AM, as we do not have supervision prior to that.**

- Breakfast will be served on campus from 8:00-8:15 AM and is FREE to all students. Students wishing to eat breakfast at school should go to the Tiger Terrace (entrance by the CMS track) during this time. The front door and Tiger Terrace door will open at 8:15 AM for students to head to their homeroom class for an 8:20 AM start time.
- Lunch will be served on campus and is FREE to all students. Students MUST sign up for lunch during their homeroom class each day in order to receive a school lunch.
- Don't forget your masks.** Masks must be worn indoors. Students refusing to wear a mask will be enrolled in the Creswell Online Academy.
- Don't forget a refillable water bottle and snack for break.**
- Social distancing is expected** when entering and exiting the building, visiting in the courtyard, and transitioning in the hallways.
- School Pictures** will be on Friday, September 22nd. Dorian picture packets will be sent home. Picture ordering is also available by going to [www.dorianstudio.com](http://www.dorianstudio.com) and searching for Creswell Middle School.
- Students enrolled at CMS should pay their student body fee and athletic fees as soon as possible. Students will be given their elective schedules on the first day of school. At that time, parents/guardian should pay these fees.** Fee amounts are listed in the CMS Student Handbook, which is posted online. Parents/Guardians can pay by calling the CMS office with a credit card, or sending a check to CMS with their student.
- Students wishing to enroll in beginning band, intermediate band, or choir, should contact the CMS office as soon as possible.** For the 2021-2022 school year, Choir will be held before school from 7:45-8:35 AM. Beginning Band will be held from 9:53-10:53 AM and Intermediate Band will be held from 8:39-9:39 AM. Because students in Band will miss either their in-person Science or History class, he/she will be enrolled in an Acellus (online) Science/History class where he/she will complete their grade level contact.
- Return the "First Day" Forms & Permissions sheet (as well as enclosed documents) to your student's homeroom teacher (please have your student bring them on the first day of school).**

This Technology Use and Device Loan Agreement is in accordance with the District Policy: Electronic Communications System IIBGA and IIBGA-AR. Please read the following policies and sign the second page to acknowledge responsibilities.

- Intentional damage or repeated accidental damage to a device will result in fees for the cost of repairs and parts.
- The device should only be used by the student to whom it has been assigned.
- The device must be returned to the School or District when requested by the School or District to do so.

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# Digital Online Learning Permission

**What is Zoom?** Zoom is an online meeting platform where the teacher can meet with students online. Teachers will teach online lessons and students join with audio and video. Students can access the scheduled Zoom session using a desktop, laptop, or iPad. These sessions can be 1:1 or in groups. This means that the teacher might schedule a session with the student individually for lesson help or in a large and small group for instruction.

**What do I need to know?** When a meeting is scheduled there will be a private link shared with the unique meeting ID and/or password. This meeting number is unique to each session and will allow them to sign in to the meeting. Students need to be ontime. When signing in, students will be put into a virtual waiting room and the teacher will have to allow them into the meeting. This will happen in the first few minutes before and at the meeting start time.

**PARENTAL CONSENT TO USE ZOOM** Creswell School District encourages participation by students in Zoom video conferencing meetings with Creswell staff and students. This interaction will provide an opportunity for students to socialize with one another and receive live synchronous instruction from their teachers.
