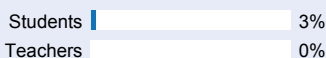

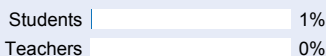

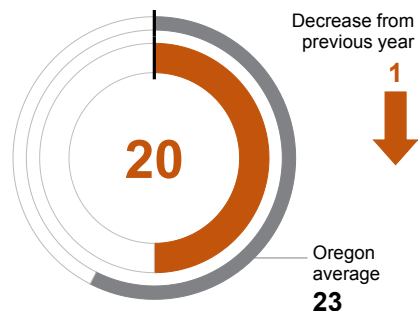

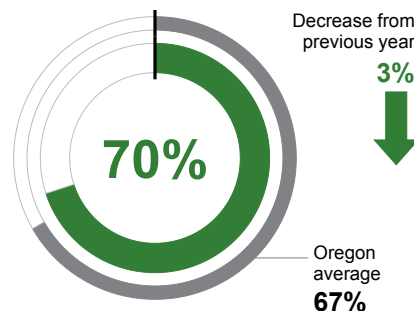
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

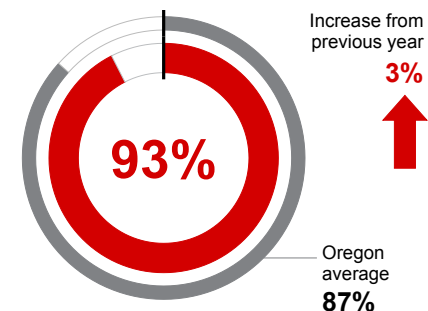
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

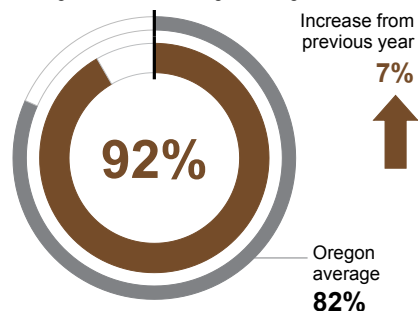
Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.

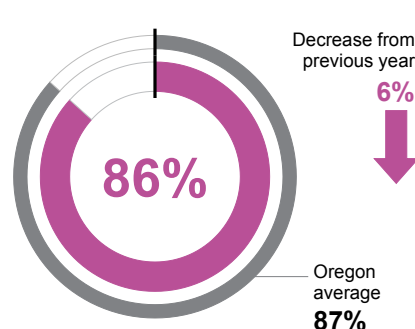
ON-TIME GRADUATION

Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2020-21 graduating in 2023-24.



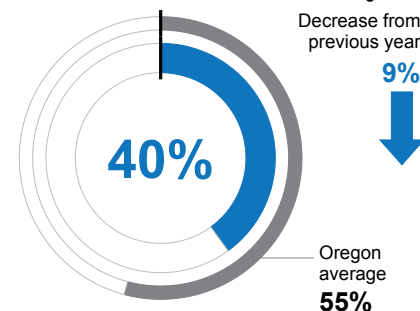
FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

ADVANCED COURSEWORK

Creswell High School offers a wide variety of advanced courses, including Honors and AP classes, as well as opportunities to earn dual credit through our partnerships with local colleges. These rigorous courses allow students to explore academic interests and prepare them for college and a future career.
