



PROPOSED SCHOOL BOND INFORMATION MEETINGS

Learn more about the proposed \$18,210,000 school bond measure that will be on the May 16 ballot.

If passed, the proposed bond would:

- Fund repairs and updates to schools
- Improve safety and security
- Expand access to vocational training
- Estimated to not increase current bond tax rate
- Qualify the district to receive a \$4 million state matching grant. The district would receive the matching grant only if the proposed bond passes.

What would the proposed bond cost if it passes?

- \$18,210,000 proposed bond measure, to be repaid over 21 years
- Bond tax rate is estimated to not increase because an existing bond is retiring in 2027
- Estimated bond tax rate would remain \$1.94 per \$1,000 of assessed property value
- An estimated \$388 per year, or \$32.33 per month, for a home assessed at \$200,000
