



Frequently Asked Questions

As part of our portfolio of student support, Creswell District offers an online option for students. Creswell online is a fully remote, self-paced online learning program available to students in grades K-12, with the flexibility to enroll full-time. Even while participating in Creswell Online, students remain fully connected to the district, retaining their school counselor to maintain strong ties to their home school. To ensure success in this program, students are required to demonstrate academic progress on a weekly basis and maintain daily contact by completing assignments.

How and when do I enroll?

You may submit an interest form using the following [link](#). Once submitted, Creswell staff will reach out to you to schedule a meeting to discuss whether online school is the right fit for your student. To ensure credit completion, CSD students may only transition into Creswell Online at semester breaks with administrator approval. Exceptions may be made for eligible transfer students.

What are the program requirements?

As a part of Oregon state requirements, students in Creswell Online are required to make academic progress weekly and “attend” online classes daily. Attendance is taken by completing tasks in the online platform.

Does Creswell Online provide technology and materials to the students?

Yes! Like all Creswell students we provide a Chromebook for each student. See our CSD Technology agreement [here](#).

Can I accelerate my progress through the program? Can I enroll in more than the recommended maximum number of courses?

Yes! We allow you to move quickly through the courses. You are able to move as quickly or as slowly as you see fit. We do encourage you to finish your assigned courses before moving on to the next course as this ensures you can stay on track. Courses must be completed by the end of the given semester for credit.

Can students participate in all Creswell activities?

Yes! Students are considered Creswell students and can participate in all activities.

Will students stay on track to graduate?

Yes! Your student will keep their counselor when in Creswell Online and the counselor will be listed as the “coach” online so they are continually getting updates about the student’s program and progress. Our counselors are the ones making the recommendations about which courses the student will be enrolled in so that your student stays on track for graduation.

Do I still have teachers?

Yes, but not a Creswell district teacher. Creswell Online teachers are fully remote and the responsibility of our online provider. Students will have an individual teacher per course/content.

Do I need to attend “live” classes?

No. With our online provider, there are “advisory” classes and “live” sessions that are more like “office hours” where students can go to get additional support. Students are not required to attend anything live.

Can students do College in High School?

Yes! We can identify options with your high school counselor.

How can I track how my student is doing?

Around the middle of the month, you will receive a progress report via email. In addition, each month you will receive progress monitoring emails per class. You will also receive weekly



emails from your online teachers.

What if I feel Creswell Online is not the best fit or it doesn't work for me?

If you find the program is not working for you, please contact Amy Aguero at aaguero@creswell.k12.or.us for support. You can leave Creswell Online at any time, but we do want to make sure we are doing everything we can to ensure the program is a fit for you.
